Potholes are developing on the blacktop roads and the gravels are turning soft, muddy and rough, The Road Commission Crews will be patching potholes as they develop. Gravel roads provide a bigger challenge. As the frost continues to work out of the ground, time is the best healer- Often it is better that we keep our heavy vehicles off the gravels as the added heavy traffic can do more damage than good Attempting to add large amounts of gravel or extensive grading only creates more mud.

We will continue to monitor the gravel roads and provide the appropriate maintenance.
