

Significant Events and/or Alarms

- Mutual aid given to Algoma FD on July 6 on US 131 near mile marker 103.5 for a wildland fire.
- On July 12, SFD responded to a car versus tree crash in front of 17641 White Creek Drive N.E. Upon responding, updated information indicated an unresponsive, trapped driver. Sand Lake FD was requested for man power support and Spectrum Aero-med helicopter was requested. Arrival found the singularly occupied vehicle as reported. However, the driver was removed through the rear passenger door in a rapid manner without the need for extrication tools. Sand Lake FD and Aeromed were disregarded. SFD provided a driver for the ambulance for the trip to the hospital.
- On July 30, SFD along with our automatic aid partners of Sand Lake, Algoma, and Kent City fire
 departments responded to a detached garage fire at 4655 Grosvenor Street. Arrival found the
 structure near collapse with a near-by vehicle burning also. The building was a complete loss.
 Cedar Springs FD was requested for mutual aid also. No injuries occurred at this event.
- SFD participated in three public relations events including Lake Side Camp Park's annual safety day, Duke Creek campgrounds inaugural safety day with plans to make an annual event, and a kid's backpacks for school giveaway at the local Verizon Store in Cedar Springs. Significant relations, communications, and financial contributions to the ACCD fundraising campaign were gained at these events.
- Encouraged to report that both the new personnel, FF Hays and FF Robinson, who have come to SFD with all the necessary certifications and licensing have "hit the ground running" with great participation.
- FF's Grady and Schmidt have passed their MFR course. FF Grady has also passed the necessary National Registry exam as an MFR. FF Schmidt is in the process of scheduling.
- The MI-OSHA citation has arrived, paperwork submitted to Supervisor, notification requirements have been posted appropriately, building survey for Asbestos has been initiated by the vendor, Target Solutions software has provided the employee education for asbestos awareness
- Origination of EMS reports through the new state compliant vendor "Image Trend Elite" has been successful.

- On July 18, the Solon Township Board approved the purchase of a 4000 gallon, 1,500gpm Tender/Pumper. The contract with B & B Truck Fire Division has been signed and the vendor has started work on the chassis. Delivery is expected in July 2017.
- On July 14, SFD engine 1 and engine 2 travelled to Plainfield FD for pump testing by the low bid vendor solicited by the Kent County Fire Commission. Both trucks passed without issue.
- Received notification of an unsuccessful grant application though the Lowe's Community Foundation for the purchase of an ACCD.
