

- 64 Alarms for the month, busy. Three alarms SFD gave aid, and received aid on four alarms.
- Station Coverage for Full Time position approved leave

- On July 1, SFD responded to 11 alarms after a severe storm rolled through the area knocking down many trees and power lines. No injuries reported.
- On July 3, SFD was requested by the Grant FD to respond to a large commercial fire just west of the city in Newaygo County. SFD had crews on scene about four hours.
- Other aid given was one each to Cedar Springs and Kent City FD.
- In early June, FF Cebrero, FF Schievink, FF Nielsen, & Chief Drake enrolled in a Basic Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) class that runs through mid- September. The ½ way mark recently obtained, is a significant milestone to the students as we grind through the classes. Class is held every Wednesday 1800-2200 hours and one Saturday a month from 0800-1600 hours. The Basic EMT is the next higher level above the Medical First Responder (MFR) in Michigan. This license will be a very attractive item to list on the resume for the young FF's seeking career positions.
- On July 27 a regional grant application submitted earlier this year by the joint efforts of Cedar Springs FD, Sand Lake FD, and Solon FD was officially approved for award. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighter's Grant (AFG) was awarded for the purchase of Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA). Solon FD will be receiving 16 new SCBA's with a value of 110,200. The grant requires a 10 % match. Equipment procurement will take three to six months.
