Outside of Station Functions/ Significant Events, Alarms:

- Deputy Chief Paige attended a Cardiac Resuscitation Improvement Class sponsored by Kent County EMS at Cascade Township delivered by Stryker.
- DC Paige provided make up fire academy classes to SFD participant. DC Paige also participated as instructor at the fire academy on four dates
- FF Schievink provided station coverage on 12-21-19 for 2.5 hours
- On 12-26-2019, SFD was dispatched to Long Lake Park for a report of a man fell thru the ice and trapped. SFD responded with two trucks and six personnel. SFD personnel donned the ice rescue suit and successfully removed the victim from the water. The victim was transported to the hospital suffering from hypothermia. - On 12-11-19, SFD responded to 17550 McPhail for a possible structure fire with our auto aid partners including, Kent City, Algoma, and Sand Lake fire departments. The pellet stove malfunctioned and filled the whole house with smoke, no fire extension was found. SFD assisted with removing the smoke.
- On 12-12-19, SFD travelled to Kent City for fire training at the old Baptist Church. This site
 provided an excellent opportunity to review and execute the subject material in a near real
 scenario. Subject matter included the strategy of: Vent, Enter, Isolate, Search.



 - The victim was fishing alone on the 1" thick ice
 - A county park worker heard the victim calling for help
 - The victim was transported to the hospital with hypothermia
