Outside of Station Functions, Significant Events, Alarms:

- Covid 19 has made tremendous impact on staff and operations. Most noted is the extra time spent disinfecting and cleaning equipment, trucks, and facilities. Daily EMS updates have arrived since March 16 from Kent County Emergency Medical Services. These updates include PPE recommendations, inventory queries, and emergency pandemic protocol changes/updates. Another requirement is the reporting of PPE stock to the State three times a week. This is expected to increase to daily reporting. As mentioned earlier, the Fire Chief has implemented a stand-by duty rotation for the officer group to provide leadership assistance in navigating the uncharted waters of this pandemic. The goal of the stand-by duty is to assure an officer is available for every call 24-7 until the pandemic is over.
- Due to the Social Distancing and Stay Home/Stay Safe requirements, regular bi-monthly department training have been suspended. Personnel will continue to work on Target Solution assignments and Individual Training Time (ITT) independently. Small group trainings are permitted while maintaining the distance rules as part of an essential service. Stay Home, Stay Safe.
- Due to Covid 19, staff has been directed **not** to make social visits to the fire station. Staff must only gather at the station for alarms and small group training. During this time, social distancing rules shall be executed where possible.
- Small quantity of PPE obtained from Region 6 cache including: surgical masks and gowns. Other safety equipment purchases were made at local vendors.
- Personnel enrolled in the MFFTC academy are anxiously awaiting direction from the state on plan to finish this course once pandemic restrictions are lifted.
- Birthday Party drive-by with fire trucks (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xkLQedSzIBI>). Maybe you have seen the stories about the local FD's driving by a resident's home as a way to provide a celebration during the pandemic. Due to the Stay Home, Stay Safe and social distancing rules issued under executive orders of the Governor, SFD will not be able to provide this measure for our residents. Alarm response is the only time our staff will risk not violating these rules as a part of our conscious effort to "flatten the curve" of Covid19. Happy Birthday to all those deserving from your friends as Solon Fire Department. Come and see us after the pandemic and we will show you the trucks.
- SFD provided mutual aid to Algoma and Plainfield fire departments at structure fire alarms respectively in the month of March. SFD received aid for one structure fire alarm in Solon Township from Algoma, Cedar Springs, and Kent City in the month of March (Table above). Since 2012, this is the first time aid given has outpaced aid received for alarms.
