# **Outside of Station Functions, Significant Events, Alarms:**

- On 8-16-2020, FF Matt Schievink was offered and accepted the full time position at SFD. Matt will be working M-F 0630-1630 hours, with a start date of September 8, 2020. Matt will be a great resource for mentoring new personnel and assisting DC Paige with training delivery.
- On 9-24-20, a young girl from Solon Township by the name of Grace Fittro, with the assistance of her grandfather, Timothy Krygier, donated a hand-made memorial US flag replica. The stripes of the flag are made from old fire hose and it is adorned with fire tools. The flag was mounted on the wall in the classroom and is a very welcome addition. Mr Krygier desired to donate the flag to memorialize the service by the SFD members to the community. Thank you very much to the Krygier and Fittro families. See photos below.
- Lieutenant Robinson successfully completed the Michigan Fire Fighter Training Council (MFFTC) Instructor 1 program in Hart MI. This class occurred over two weekends in September. This certification was a minimum requirement for the Lieutenant position he accepted in February 2020. Congratulations Lt. Robinson, this was a heavy commitment of time on your behalf.
- Chief Drake has obtained a return to work order from the Work Compensation physician effective September 16, 2020. This leave started August 30 which resulted in a low percentage of alarm response for the month.
- All apparatus passed NFPA pump testing and DOT safety inspections after some repairs.
- A respiratory arrest medical alarm on Seventeen Mile Road was successfully converted with the use of Naloxone by SFD.
- Deputy Chief Paige took some time away from SFD as he started his new full time position.

# **Repairs to Station**

- Vendor troubleshooting OH door opener for Medic 1. The opener quit working after installation
  of the LED bulbs which is suspected of causing interference with the radio signal. The analog
  circuit board was replaced in lieu of the digital board but to no avail. Still investigating possible
  interference source.
- The lower level bathroom and medical supply storage area is getting some rehab. This project will include the repair of a leaky water supply valve for the toilet, new toilet, wall and floor paint, and re-organization of medical supplies.
- The rain gutters were cleaned out. The gutters on the south side of the building were accessed via a safety harness and fall arrestor that were borrowed.
