# **Outside of Station Functions, Significant Events, Alarms:**

- Covid 19 still is providing an impact on staff and operations, although it is becoming a bit more routine. Of note, is the extra time necessary to don appropriate PPE for a positive Emergency Medical Dispatch (EMD) screening. Also, there is the extra time necessary to disinfect and clean equipment, trucks, and facilities upon return to the station. All of this adds up to more minutes from staff on each positive Covid19 alarm. The daily updates from KCEMS regarding important data, intelligence, or protocol changes have waned to one per week toward the latter half of the month.
- SFD is participating in a group purchase of the disinfectant "Transform". This product is aerosolized using an SCBA and a paint gun to disinfect personnel, equipment, and facilities. The primary advantage of the group purchase is to combat the 15-day shelf life of the product once mixed. The EOC is also examining a purchase as part of the Covid19 response. - A beneficial side of the pandemic has been an increase of personnel available for daytime alarms. Four personnel have been furloughed or assigned to work from home.
- A small storage out-building was intentionally ignited by the property owner on April 5 at 2980 Solon Road. The fire quickly spread to an adjacent building not desired to be razed. SFD was

able to suppress the fire with minimal damage to the building not intended to be razed. Mutual aid was requested for Cedar Springs FD and was cancelled prior to arrival. Property loss was listed as \$ 500.00

- On April 9, SFD responded to a residential fire with notification via a monitored alarm system at 13725 East Harmony. Typically, these types of alarms are a result of burned food or dust from construction. However, this alarm was different as the detector alerted the occupant of a fire on the stove top. The occupant extinguished the fire and quickly exited the structure with her two small children due to smoke. SFD arrived to find smoke in the residence and assisted the owner with ventilation via windows. The dollar loss was listed as zero as the item burned was a cardboard box.
- A detached garage type building fire was reported April 20 at 15750 Simmons Avenue. First arriving apparatus found a small fire on the exterior wall and quickly extinguished using a hose line. Automatic aid was provided by Algoma, Cedar Springs, and Sand Lake fire departments. The cause of the fire is listed as undetermined. The building was not insured. Property loss was listed as \$ 500.00.
